Section 1. The Chamber shall have a seal of such design as the Board of Directors may adopt.

ARTICLE XII. PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

Section 1. All questions of parliamentary procedure shall be determined according to Robert's Revised Rules of Order, and in the absence of a specially prepared program, the order of business recommended in said Rules shall be followed.

ARTICLE XIII. AMENDMENTS

Section 1. This Constitution may be amended only by a two-thirds vote of a quorum present at any regular or special meeting of the Chamber, provided, however, that notice of the proposed amendment shall have been mailed by the Secretary to each member not less than ten (10) days prior to such meeting.

Section 2. All proposed amendments shall first receive the approval of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XIV. INTERPRETATION

Wherever the masculine gender shall be used herein, the same shall be deemed to include the female gender.
